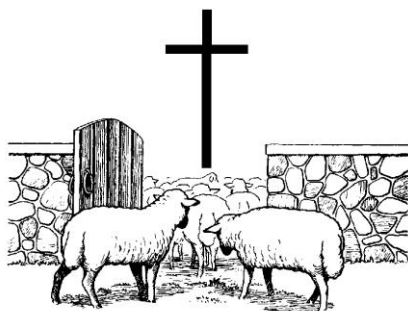

RELATED TO CLC CALL NEWS – FROM CLC PRESIDENT EICHSTADT

On Monday the CLC Board of Doctrine met via Zoom with Terry Stringer for the first stage of our colloquy procedure. The interview went very well and upon the board's recommendation, I'm declaring him eligible for a call to serve as a vacancy pastor with the understanding that during this time he would be under the mentorship of a nearby pastor. The board has also recommended that he pursue some additional education at ILC or in another program developed by the CLC, if agreeable to the congregation. Another interview for the second stage of the colloquy process will be scheduled in the future.

READINGS FOR HOME DEVOTIONS NOVEMBER 16-21, 2020

Monday - Isaiah 52:1-6 The midnight hour is approaching us, too, when Jesus takes us home with Him, so *wake up, captives* of planet Earth! Since we have *sold ourselves cheaply*, Jesus sold Himself to compensate (3). When it seems we are as bad off with our pandemic as Jews were with their exile, remember that God and is on top of our predicaments. Come quickly, Lord Jesus, before Your saints lose their/our grip on Your grace and mercy! Amen.

Tuesday - Matthew 25:1-13 It was a bride's waiting game (When would her man arrive and take her to his home?), so her friends stayed up all night to keep her company. The point Jesus is making: be prepared to burn midnight oil if you want to share in the festivities (10). The girls who had a second, reserve jar of oil were the smart ones (4). Now, what does the oil represent? Probably saving faith that equips God's saints for the long haul.

Wednesday - 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 Interested in how Judgment Day plays out? First, Jesus descends from heaven; then He awakens the dead from their sleep; then the newly awakened/resurrected persons join up with the saints still alive, and the entire crowd levitates into the sky to meet Jesus and begin heavenly life with Him. That way, no saint comes in second-best (13-15).

Thursday - Psalm 84 Everybody values home, for home is where the heart is. We are at home with God everywhere we worship Him (1-4); all else are just stop-overs (5-7). O Lord, please work things out so that we may assemble again and join in corporate worship! Better yet, abide with us all the days of our pilgrimage and hasten Your return to all waiting saints. Thank You.

Friday - Luke 20:27-40 Marriage is good for humanity because the next generation starts with babies born to husband and wife (27-34). Now then, since nobody in heaven gets old and nobody dies, there's no need for procreation via marriage (34-36). Back at square one: heaven is not a graveyard, but the home of saints alive and functional (37-38). Case closed.

Saturday - Acts 18:24-28 Apollos (now among the saints in heaven) was not only well educated and *eloquent* (Alexandria in Egypt was his home town, a city renowned for its library and universities), he was also *educated and eloquent* with God's Word (24-25). Nonetheless, the most learned person can learn from others (26) so that the Holy Spirit can use His saints to prove *from the Scriptures that Jesus of Nazareth is the Chosen One* (27-28). Bottom line: God interacts with mortals via His Word, both Old and New Testaments, and we are His spokespersons. He who has ears, let him hear what Jesus has done to sin and hell—to redeem sinners and take His saints home to heaven. Amen!

General Fund – October offerings of \$72,598 vs disbursements of \$74,960 nearly covered expenses for the month, yet there remains a sizeable CBP General Fund deficit. Looking down the last Balance column above, we can rejoice at the blessing of the very positive balances in all our other funds! But our CBP General Fund is our most critical fund to support because it pays the general operating expenses of our church body. It does bear repeating that **our Boards of Trustees, Regents, Missions, and Ed & Publications receive their major funding through our regular offerings to our CLC General Fund.** It's nearing that time of the year & church year when God's people typically are taking stock of all His blessings, naturally the material part, but especially His spiritual blessings flowing from His Word & Sacrament. These work the marvelous response of thanks-giving from the heart & lips & treasury. Please remember our CLC General Fund.

ILC Operations– ILC October revenue of \$103,203 vs disbursements of \$110,739, a little more than received this month, but still a positive balance.

ILC Building Projects – With the CLC long term indebtedness on the Academic Center & North Hall paid in full, leaving a million dollar balance on hand from a member Charitable Remainder Trust, an ILC Planning Committee has been named to recommend to our next CLC Convention a new gym on campus, and continuing to use the 50-year-old gym for ILC chapels, band/choir practices, plays, musicals, & CLC larger gatherings. All glory to our gracious God from whom these blessings flow!

CEF – October revenue was \$28,283 from congregations' CEF loan payments vs disbursements of \$92,663 in CEF debt service for a new \$69,000 congregational loan and \$20,000 in CEF Promissory Notes repaid to members. The Trustees are aware of possible loans to use the \$3 million balance.

MDF – October offerings of \$8,190 vs disbursements of \$11,910, which includes the 5th of 12 \$10,000 construction loan installments for the Nepal Bible Institute classroom.

IIF – October disbursements included \$65,674 for ILC 24-hr security locks on all campus buildings. "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this," says the LORD of hosts, "if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.
