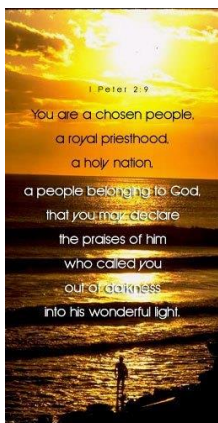

BIBLE READINGS FOR DEVOTIONS – SEPTEMBER 12-17, 2022

Monday - Luke 15:1-10 The Pharisees and scribes grumbled about Jesus receiving sinners. He responded with a double parable about one lost sheep of a hundred being worth finding, and one lost coin out of ten being worth finding. Then He pointed out that the angels in heaven were not grumbling but rejoicing over one sinner who returns to God.

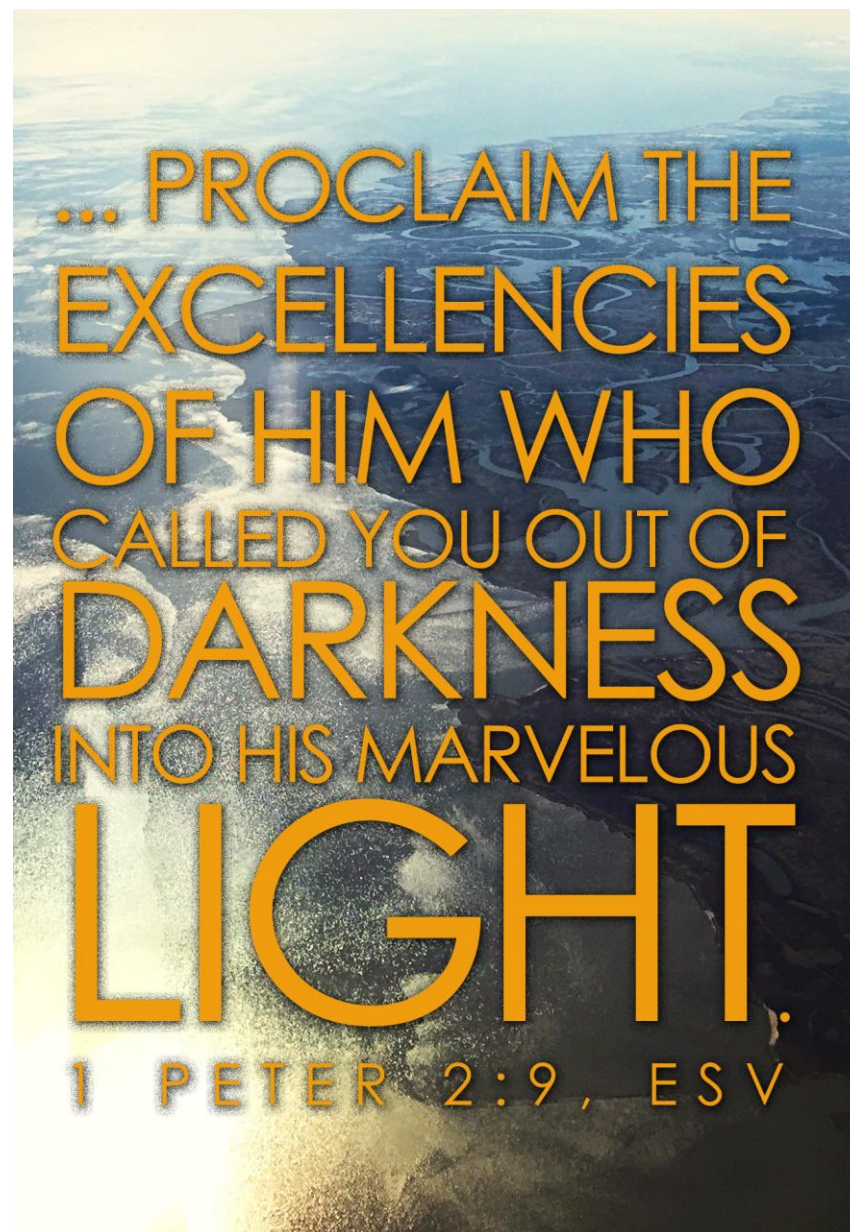
Tuesday - 2 Corinthians 2:5-11 The Corinthians had excluded a manifestly impenitent man. Now he had repented, but some perhaps thought it too easy for him if he was simply received back. Paul urged them to show their love and receive him. We are reminded again how Jesus received tax collectors and sinners seeking forgiveness.

Wednesday - Hosea 3:1-5 Hosea's life was used by God as a parable to call out to His people who were guilty of spiritual adultery, going after other gods. His purpose in all of this was that the children of Israel should return and seek the Lord their God, and come to His goodness in the latter days (v5).

Thursday - Exodus 32:7-14 Once the spiritual adultery of the children of Israel showed itself on mount Sinai, where the people made a golden calf and worshiped it. When the LORD expressed his anger, Moses interceded for them, reminding the LORD of His gracious promises. The LORD was favorable to such reliance on His sure Word.

Friday - 1 Timothy 1:12-17 Paul cannot speak enough about the grace that overflowed to him with faith and love in connection with Jesus. He counted himself foremost among sinners, a blasphemer and persecutor, and yet Christ Jesus came into the world to save even him! Surely such a Savior deserves our honor, glory and trust!

Saturday - Psalm 51:10-15 David, guilty among other things of murder and adultery, repented and found forgiveness in the Lord. Now he prays for a clean heart that finds in the Lord's salvation both joy and a willing spirit. "Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you" (v13).

EPISTLE LESSON:

HEBREWS 12:18-24

¹⁸ For you have not come to what may be touched, a blazing fire and darkness and gloom and a tempest ¹⁹ and the sound of a trumpet and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that no further messages be spoken to them. ²⁰ For they could not endure the order that was given, "If even a beast touches the mountain, it shall be stoned." ²¹ Indeed, so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, "I tremble with fear." ²² But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering, ²³ and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, ²⁴ and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel. **

And he said to them, ²⁴"**Strive to enter through the narrow door. For many, I tell you, will seek to enter and will not be able.** ²⁵**When once the master of the house has risen and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and to knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, open to us,' then he will answer you, 'I do not know where you come from.'** ²⁶**Then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in your presence, and you taught in our streets.'** ²⁷**But he will say, 'I tell you, I do not know where you come from.
