

## READINGS FOR DEVOTIONS – JANUARY 16-21, 2023

**Monday - Matthew 3:13-17** The glory of the Child of Bethlehem was revealed many times throughout His life. Here at the beginning of His ministry He came to John for baptism, not because He needed to repent but because it was the right thing for those He came to represent. The Spirit and the Father testified to His divine glory.


**Tuesday - 2 Corinthians 4:3-6** The apostle Paul also proclaimed the gospel which revealed “the glory of Christ, who is the image of God” (v4). Through the gospel proclamation God has also shined in our hearts, giving us the gift of beholding God’s glory in the face of Jesus Christ (v6).

**Wednesday - Isaiah 2:2-5** Isaiah looks forward to the “latter days,” when people from all over the world come to worship in spirit and in truth. Truly these are the days of glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill to men. Come, let us walk in the light of the LORD.

**Thursday - John 1:35-42** John declares that Jesus is “the Lamb of God,” and two disciples of John follow Jesus, not because He looked so glorious, but because they heard John’s testimony. Jesus invites them to come with Him, and one of them, Andrew, goes and brings his brother to Jesus also.

**Friday - 2 Corinthians 6:14 – 7:1** To come and see Jesus (John 1:39) is to be with God and to be His people. It is a wonderful thing that the Lord Almighty wants to be a Father to us, and this moves us to behave as His own children and to cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit.

**Saturday - Psalm 122** “Let us go to the house of the Lord” has a wonderful sound because of whose house it is! He brings people together in thanksgiving and praise. In His house there is peace – peace with God and peace with one another. It is the peace of God that “will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:7).

<sup>3</sup> Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

<sup>4</sup> I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, <sup>5</sup> that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge— <sup>6</sup> even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you— <sup>7</sup> so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>8</sup> who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup> God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. \*

### PSALM 50

<sup>1</sup>The Mighty One, God the LORD, speaks and summons the earth from the  
rising of the sun to its setting. <sup>2</sup>Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God  
shines forth. <sup>3</sup>Our God comes; he does not keep silence; before him is a  
devouring fire, around him a mighty tempest. <sup>4</sup>He calls to the heavens  
above and to the earth, that he may judge his people: <sup>5</sup>"Gather to me my  
faithful ones, who made a covenant with me by sacrifice!" <sup>6</sup>The heavens  
declare his righteousness, for God himself is judge! *Selah*

<sup>7</sup>"Hear, O my people, and I will speak; O Israel, I will testify against you. I  
am God, your God. <sup>8</sup>Not for your sacrifices do I rebuke you; your burnt  
offerings are continually before me. <sup>9</sup>I will not accept a bull from your  
house or goats from your folds. <sup>10</sup>For every beast of the forest is mine,  
the cattle on a thousand hills. <sup>11</sup>I know all the birds of the hills, and all  
that moves in the field is mine.

<sup>12</sup>"If I were hungry, I would not tell you, for the world and its fullness are  
mine. <sup>13</sup>Do I eat the flesh of bulls or drink the blood of goats? <sup>14</sup>Offer to  
God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High,  
<sup>15</sup>and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall  
glorify me."

<sup>16</sup>But to the wicked God says: "What right have you to recite my statutes  
or take my covenant on your lips? <sup>17</sup>For you hate discipline, and you cast  
my words behind you. <sup>18</sup>If you see a thief, you are pleased with him, and  
you keep company with adulterers. <sup>19</sup>"You give your mouth free rein for  
evil, and your tongue frames deceit. <sup>20</sup>You sit and speak against your  
brother; you slander your own mother's son. <sup>21</sup>These things you have  
done, and I have been silent; you thought that I was one like yourself. But  
now I rebuke you and lay the charge before you.

<sup>22</sup>"Mark this, then, you who forget God, lest I tear you apart, and there  
be none to deliver! <sup>23</sup>The one who offers thanksgiving as his sacrifice  
glorifies me; to one who orders his way rightly I will show the salvation of  
God!"\*
